



Further, on or about March 19, 1998, minors' mother physically abused minors' cousin who resided in the home, Faduma Sara A. Such abuse included, but was not limited to, striking minors; cousin with objects and her hands; and grabbing a necklace around the cousin's neck which resulted in an abrasion to the cousins's neck. Minors are in danger of such abuse. John Rindernecht, father of minor, Faduma Ayann, failed to protect the minor.
