Dear Mr. Lasseur:

I represent Dr. Scott Loeliger in the matter regarding his daughter, the minor child Fatima Busaat Loeliger.

As represented by Dr. Loeliger, and after an in-depth review of the correspondence and documentation he has provided me, it is clear you, your production company, the TV station and your "sponsor" are prepared to defame my client, invade his privacy, and to exploit the child in ways contrary to her best interests.

It is clear that despite receipt of various legal, psychological, and court documents it is your persistent intention to air a documentary about the effects of domestic abuse which has Fatima Loeliger stating that she was physically abused by her father and wrongfully removed from her mother's home by an incompetent, corrupt family law and child welfare system. You have chosen to ignore findings and various psychological evaluations from another court that legally found her mother, Sadiya Ailire, liable for abusing 3 children in her home. One of these children was Fatima, who was removed by child protective custody and placed in the protective custody of her father, Scott Loeliger.

Since neither Fatima nor her mother have mentioned the existence of these findings, which are indisputable, I must assume that they have chosen to attack another process in the county where the abuse was followed up. There have been no such findings against the father, and child protective reviews in two subsequent counties have never substantiated Fatima's claim of child abuse in her father's home.


First Amendment standards dictate your responsibility to the tell the truth and to research your material. Your refusal to incorporate actual findings, not just allegations in a high conflict case, indicates you are more interested in the prurient nature of this child's misfortune than you are in helping her or other children just like her. Your offer of allowing Dr. Loeliger to be in your documentary and in obscuring his name and that of his child in no way alleviates your legal and journalistic responsibility, and this offer is hereby rejected.

Rest assured that the doctor will pursue this matter in both a legal and public forum to prevent further

damage to his life and reputation, as well as the life and reputation of Fatima. . I expect you to immediately expunge that portion of your documentary containing Fatima Loeliger, her mother Sadiya Alilire and Dr. Loeliger and any mention thereof. You have been manipulated by the real abuser, using severe psychological pressure on the child, into rewriting her abusive history.

You should have your attorneys contact me immediately regarding this matter. I expect to review a final version of the presentation, without any reference to Fatima or her father, at least thirty (30) days prior to the airing of this documentary.
