

DECLARATION OF

TERRI L. SAIS

93-159947

I, TERRI L. SAIS declare as follows:

1. I resided on 334 Capital Street and since December share rent with Respondent.
2. I was here when Petitioner called Respondent on three occasions on Saturday, 2-21-91 leaving messages that he had been called to work at 4:00 p.m. and that Fatima would be here with me.
3. At 9:00 p.m. the police came stating Sadia had called them since Fatima was not returned. I told them Petitioner had left messages that he had to work and she could pick up the baby here. The police called Sadia and told her the child was find and Petitioner would bring Fatima home in the morning.
4. At around 10:00 p.m., Respondent came and knocked on the door. I opened it and told her I would bring Fatima out after I changed her.
5. Respondent pushed the door open and seemed very upset. She followed me into the bedroom. I picked up Fatima to change her diaper and Respondent hit me in the back of my head while I was holding the baby. She grabbed Fatima who began crying and told me "I better leave her daughter alone." She yelled other comments at me including that she could "mess with me". She said "I left you alone for a lot of months but I can really mess up your life" and "I see you on the freeway" and "If you don't want your child to be screwed up, you better leave mine alone."

1 6. I tried to call the police at one point and Respondent  
2 grabbed the phone from me. At this time, my one month old son  
3 began crying and Respondent said "let's go look at Ryan." I  
4 was afraid of what she could do so I said no. Respondent  
5 pulled my hair, hit me again on the back of my head and spit  
6 on me.

7 7. At one point Fatima began crying and Respondent put a  
8 blanket over her head. I asked her to leave and Respondent  
9 told me she didn't have to leave and said "I should get your  
10 baby and throw him out on the street. She began tearing things  
11 off the wall including one of Petitioner's wall hangings. She  
12 removed the blankets from the crib including one which my  
13 mother gave me which she eventually returned.

14 8. My son continued to cry and she told me to go get him.  
15 I went to his bedroom, locked the door and called 911. I heard  
16 the door close and saw Respondent putting blankets and things  
17 she took into a car. I locked the front door and she returned  
18 and knocked on the door asking if she could come back in.

19 9. I told the police at first that I had not seen any of my  
20 things missing but realized the next day that my wallet was  
21 gone with all my credit cards.

22 10. Respondent was very angry and alternated between seeming  
23 relaxed and then seconds later went into a rage. I am very  
24 afraid of this woman and want her to leave me alone. I was  
25 also shocked at the way she grabbed her own child and how she  
26 proceeded to threaten and abuse me without any regard for the  
27 fact that she was holding her own child.
